WEEKLY VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

(Detailed job descriptions are available on our website)

Food Prep/Kitchen Help:

You will assist the Cooks with basic food prep (salads, juice, vegetables), serving and cleaning. You will be assigned to one of the following 6 hour shifts: 7am - 1pm or 2pm - 8pm. This will give you the remainder of the day to be involved in the camp program (group leader etc.). You must be at least 18 years old and have basic meal preparation experience.

Dish Crew: (August 22-28 only)

You will be responsible for the set up and clean up of all camp meals. The number of hours you are in the kitchen varies depending on your speed and the amount of dishes to clean. It is our goal to limit your work time to 6-7 hours so that you have time to be involved in the camp program. You must be 18 years of age or older to be on the dish crew.

Speaker:

You are responsible to prepare three 5 min. staff devotions, 6 evening campfire talks and 5 morning chapel sessions. The speaker plays a vital role in presenting the truths of the gospel and allowing the staff to follow up on those truths throughout the day. You must have prior experience working with the specific age group.

Work Crew:

You will be assisting the caretaker by keeping the camp facilities and grounds clean and safe. Usually your tasks take about 6-7 hours each day, with opportunity the rest of the time to be involved in the camp program. You must be at least 15 years old.

Support Staff:

You will be assisting the program director by lending a hand with program set up and activities. Usually your tasks take about 6-7 hours each day, with opportunity the rest of the time to be involved in the camp program. You must be at least 18 years old and have served on staff in previous summers.
